

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Ashtabula City Port Authority- USEPA Brownfield Assessment Grant Program

The Ashtabula City Port Authority (Port Authority) has received a Brownfield Assessment Grant for \$200,000 from the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) for purposes of inventorying, characterizing, assessing, and planning the revitalization and reuse of brownfield properties throughout the community. The grant activities allow for community involvement, and the Port Authority is encouraging feedback and communication during this revitalization process.

The first required public meeting will be held on Thursday, February 17, 2011 at 2:00 o'clock p.m. in the Pre-Council Chambers of the Ashtabula City Municipal Building, 4717 Main Avenue, Ashtabula, Ohio, to educate the public of the Brownfield Grant Program.

The citizens of Ashtabula are encouraged to attend this meeting to express their views on areas of the City that may benefit from the Port Authority's USEPA Brownfield Assessment Grant. The Port Authority would also like to encourage residents who are proficient in other languages to inform non-English speaking citizens about the public meeting and invite them to attend and express their views or comments. If any interpreters, or special needs for handicapped, elderly or other City residents are requested of the Port Authority prior to the public meeting, the Port Authority will make every attempt to meet the required needs.
